Stakeholder Interview

The project that I am working on has many stakeholders that are affected by what is going on. My internship is at Healthy Tarrant County Collaboration, where they have many projects that involve policy system environment, resident engagement, and healthy food access. My project is centered around healthy food access by going to Mind Your Garden Urban Farm. This farm is a partner with my internship site where its focus is to provide healthy food to the members of the Southeast Fort Worth community. When asked if this is a challenge for her, she said that for her it is personally not a factor, but for other people that she knows it is since they may lack transportation.

When asked about the services that my project provides, she said that they are very helpful and beneficial to her. She also said that she lets others know about what my project does for members in her community. The views and opinions that she has on my project have a major impact on the success of my project. Since she feels positive and that it is of help, this means that my project can be successful. The more that people hear about my project then the more it will be able to expand and grow. Everything grows with recommendations and the more that the garden receives then the more funding it can receive. If the views of the community members are all the same, then that can mean that the more the farm can grow since everyone in the community would want the resources that they provide.
